

From Father Jacob

Christ is King!

Today we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. That Jesus Christ is the King of the Universe, the King of all mankind, the King of the Church, and that He belongs as the King of our hearts as well!

In the readings today we see three titles that Jesus has to be the king.

In the first reading we see David anointed to shepherd God's people Israel. Jesus is the son of David, and so He is the rightful King of Israel, including the new people Israel, the Church. Jesus is king of His Church and the Church does well only when she stays close to Him!

In the second reading we hear about Christ as "the firstborn of all creation" and "the head of the body, the Church". Christ is king of the universe because He is the creator of the universe, and everything that exists finds its purpose and goal in Him. In other words He is "the beginning and the end" and the whole universe does well when it points towards Him!

In the gospel we hear about Jesus being crucified, which does not at first glance seem very kingly. But we remember that it is on the cross also that Jesus is conquering sin and death, that he is in that moment, hidden from the mocking crowds and from all human sight, defeating the devil and is about to descend to Hell to plunder the devil's defeated kingdom. Jesus is the rightful king because He has conquered! We, who like the thief are justly doomed to die, can also call on him in just the same way: "Jesus, remember me, when you come into your kingdom."


Jesus is the rightful King because He is the son of David, because He is the source and goal of all creation, and because He is the conqueror of death and Lord of life. We should want to live in His kingdom, as his subjects, because He is also the king who Shepherds rightly, who reconciles all things, and who gives his own life for his subjects. He is the rightful king, but more than that, He is a very good king!

Jesus, remember me, when you come into your kingdom.

The first Thanksgiving

The first Thanksgiving in what is now America was held in St Augustine, Florida, in 1565, when the newly-arrived settlers celebrated a Mass of Thanksgiving for their safe journey across the ocean followed by a feast with the Timucua people who lived there. The second Thanksgiving was similar, when in El Paso, Texas, in 1598 the newly arrived settlers had a Mass of Thanksgiving for their safe journey across the desert followed by a feast with the Manso people who lived there.


