

## From Father Jacob

### Immaculate Conception

Monday (12/8) is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a day of obligation in the United States. We celebrate that, by the special grace of God, Our Lady came into being without stain of original sin or the internal division and “bent” to sin that comes with it. This great feast is very good news for all of us, not just for Mary.

**Mary's immaculate conception makes her the new Eve.** Just as Eve listened to the fallen angel and disobeyed God, and so brought forth death for all of her children, so Mary, the new Eve, listened to the angel Gabriel and gave her obedience to God, and so has brought Life-eternal Life!-to all of her children. We are Eve's children in the flesh and Mary's children by grace of adoption in Jesus Christ!

**Mary's immaculate conception protects her “yes” for all of humanity.** Mary gives the angel Gabriel her “yes” to God, the yes that will join God and man in Jesus Christ and which allows us to be joined to the life of God in Jesus Christ!

How appropriate and right that that “yes” can be a full and perfect yes, not divided or second-guessed, because Eve is preserved from the division and internal war that results in us from sin.

**Mary's immaculate conception shows us our future!** Mary lived her free from all that would separate her from God...and God wants you to live that way too! In Christ he restores us to friendship with Him, and by walking the way of Christ he is making us saints step-by-step. Someday, please God, we will reign in Heaven with Our Lady and all of us will then be immaculate too!





