

From Father Jacob

Lord every nation on Earth will adore You!

The word “epiphany” means appearance, and the feast of the Epiphany of the Lord originally celebrated the visit of the Magi, but also the baptism of the Lord and the wedding feast at Cana, all times when Jesus’s power and glory were “shown forth” to the world. Today we mostly focus on the visit of the Magi.

The visit of these wise men is important because it is the beginning of the fulfillment of God promise that His salvation is not just for one people, the Jewish people, but, through them, for all nations and peoples. The magi are not Jewish, but they recognize the coming of the Lord and come and lay their gifts before Him. God’s salvation is for the whole world, and this is the very beginning of announcing it.

The wise men bring gifts to present to the baby Jesus, and these are significant:

Gold is presented to a king. Jesus is the descendant of David, the new king of Israel. He is also the new Adam, the rightful ruler of all humanity and, as God, He is the king of the universe.

Frankincense is a kind of incense, which is burned as an offering to God. Jesus is God become a man, in whom “the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us”. The wise men also worshipped Jesus by prostrating themselves.

Myrrh is another kind of incense, one specifically used to embalm the dead. Here the wise men foretell that Jesus will die for us on the cross, and so destroy death and free us for eternal life with him. When Jesus died Nicodemus brought myrrh and other spices to embalm him (John 19:39). Some people think this is the same myrrh the wise men brought but nobody knows for sure.

Donuts and Hospitality

Our parish is lucky to have the Knights of Columbus hosting coffee and donuts after the 8 and 10 o’clock Masses the first weekend of the month. Last year we also hosted hospitality after the 4pm and noon Masses with wine, lemonade, cheese and crackers, and usually some other snacks as well.

We want to continue to host these great chances for us to get together and get to know each other, but we need your help! If your family can host one of these gatherings in 2026, **sign up to ‘host’ a month this weekend**. The parish and a generous donor provide the wine, and the parish will reimburse you for the snacks. We just need a little planning, some setup in the social hall, and good hospitality from one or two families once a month!
