From Father Jacob

When you have done all you have been commanded, say, 'We are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do.'

Keeping the commandments is not some laudable achievement, it is the minimum required. What are the commandments? Most of us know the ten commandments, given by God to Moses on Mount Sinai, and we probably know that Jesus has shown us how to understand the commandments more broadly so they can be a fuller guide to the Christian life.

Beyond the ten commandments, which are universal, there are the basic requirements of a Christian in the Church; these are often organized as the five precepts:

- 1. You shall attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation.
- 2. You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
- 3. You shall humbly receive your Creator in Holy Communion at least during the Easter season.
- 4. You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
- 5. You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church according to your ability.

Keeping the commandments doesn't earn me any special praise, it is just the basic requirement of life as a creature of God and of a Christian. I don't expect to be praised for not running red lights, I would expect to be punished for doing it. The commandments and precepts govern the minimum required of us.

Jesus calls us beyond the commandments and precepts into a sharing of His life, which is far more than just a set of rules. When I am generous to my neighbors, pray with focus and devotion, and bear sufferings for the Lord, I am going beyond the commandments and living the Gospel with Christ. I can expect to experience the presence of Christ in a life like that, and I can hope in God's promise of a treasure stored up in heaven for me.
