From Father Jacob

October is the month of the Rosary!

Last week we celebrated the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, and this whole month of October we are especially encouraged to pray the rosary. We are praying the rosary together before our weekend Masses this month.

Why do Catholics pray the Rosary? We pray it for a lot of reasons!

We pray the Rosary because we want to spend time with Mary, our mother in heaven. People often think of holding the rosary beads as "holding Mary's hand". Just as I should spend time with my earthly father and mother, so I should spend time with the mother God has given me in the order of grace: Our Lady Mary.

We pray the Rosary because we need God's help and Mary's guidance in our lives. Giving our time and attention to the Lord will always have a reward from our good God, who specifically instructs us to be persistent in our prayer. Neither the rosary nor any other prayer ever "makes" God do anything, but our Lord is so good to us that he loves to use our prayers for good!

Most importantly, we pray the rosary to keep the events of Jesus's life close to our lives. Since God has joined me to Himself through the human life of Jesus Christ, I want Jesus's life to be part of my life. Through the Rosary I can have Jesus's birth on my mind while I go for a walk; I can have his crown of thorns on my mind while I wait at the doctor; I can have his resurrection on my mind in my chair at home. Mary, who "kept all these things, pondering them in her heart" is the privileged person to lead us to ponder these things too.

Let's pray the Rosary this month! If you haven't prayed the Rosary much before, start with one decade today.

What to know about the Rosary

- The Rosary is "the Bible on a string". By praying the rosary consistently a person meditates on the life of Jesus from its beginning at the Annunciation to eternity at the right hand of the Father!
- The Rosary as we would recognize it has been prayed since the 1200s, but Catholics have been meditating using prayer beads since at least the 300s.
- Most Catholics are buried with a Rosary in their hands as a sign of devotion to prayer and to Our Lady. Hopefully your last time holding one won't also be your first time!
- The world's largest rosary is 1965 feet long and is in Beirut, Lebanon. It is made of large concrete "beads", each one the size of a car!
- St Albert school just installed a beautiful new rosary walk by the front entrance. It was an Eagle Scout project. :Look for it when you go to Oktoberfest this weekend!
- The Rosary for 800 years had three sets of five mysteries, making 150 Hail Maries, the same number as Psalms in the Bible. That way people who couldn't read or go to the monastery during the day could join the monks and nuns in praying the psalms in praise of God. Pope St John Paul II encouraged use of the Luminous Mysteries starting in 2002.
